Kevin Ryan, a freshman at Towson University majoring in Finance, was killed by a drunk driver on October 14, 2007. Kevin was a 2007 graduate from Atholton High School who played various sports and was an active member in the Boy Scouts. His parents, Angela and Charlie Ryan, established this scholarship endowment as a living memorial to Kevin and to provide financial assistance to a Towson University student who demonstrates financial need and was a member of a scouting program in high school.

- Be a full-time Towson University undergraduate student in good academic standing;
- Have written confirmation of a scouting background and been a member of a troop for at least two years at the high school level;
- Have completed and submitted the 2018 – 2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
